Passing zones are:

- Between Turn 8 Exit Point and Braking Zone of Turn 9
 Between Turn 12 Exit Point and Braking Zone for Turn 1
- ✓ <u>No passing in turns</u> (wait for car to clear turn before giving signal or making pass)
- ✓ <u>No late passing</u> (don't force any car off line into Turn 1 or Turn 9
- \checkmark Passing zones are the same for all groups

All passing (and "point-by signals") to be to left side of vehicle being overtaken

If there's somebody in your mirror, they're probably running faster than you... be considerate and give them a "point-by"

Expedite passes by lifting off the gas for a second or two and throwing ego out the window
